ISABS

The **Indian Society for Applied Behavioural Science (ISABS)** is a national non-profit voluntary professional organization founded by a group of behavioural scientists engaged in applying their knowledge and skills for the well being of persons and organizations since 1972. ISABS programmes focus on human processes and aim at helping people to understand themselves better and discover their own potential and satisfying ways of relating and working with people.

It is the only Society in India, which provides accreditation as a T-Group trainer.

METHODOLOGY

ISABS utilizes experience based learning and self analytical group processes(T-Group)as its main training method.In a group, around 8 to 12 participants assemble together and work with a facilitator to discover their strengths, interpersonal relationship, participation in the group and how they are perceived by others etc.

In this T-Group setting, the group evolves like a laboratory. The members act as resource to each other facilitating mutual learning through experiencing, reflecting,hypothesizing, experimenting and conceptualizing rather than through lectures.

BENEFITS

The persons attending the laboratories are likely to become more sensitive in understanding their own, as well as other people's feelings, needs & behaviours.

The laboratory may help a person in improving the quality of interpersonal relations with his / her subordinates, colleagues, superiors and in turn become a better team player. This leads to enhanced individual and organisational effectiveness in terms of creating a support-oriented culture.

The heightened process awareness and emotional intelligence also improves skills in Group facilitation and Change management.

THE PROGRAMMES AT THIS EVENT

1. BASIC LABORATORY ON HUMAN PROCESS (BLHP)

Objectives

- Become aware of one's own patterns of behaviour;
- Become aware of the impact of one's behaviour on others and vice versa;
- Improve one's effectiveness in interpersonal interactions so as to derive greater satisfaction from them;
- Discover one's dormant potential to live more effectively and meaningfully.

- Identify and develop greater awareness of behavioural processes associated with one's life.
- Find out options to work on the dilemmas faced in the context of perceived realities.
- Discover potential for greater effectiveness in the organization and society.
- Practice skills of observation of human processes and interventions.

For whom

Those who have participated in a Basic Laboratory on Human Process or its equivalent (L-Group / T-Group) in the past two years.

Those who want to join Professional Development Programme of ISABS may find participating in ALHP not only meaningful but also essential.

ALHP is also useful for Trainers, Internal HRD facilitators, ISO Management Representatives and personnel engaged in Change management.

While sending nominations for ALHP, following particulars must be supplied: Year and date of doing BLHP, whether attended in Regional or National Event of ISABS, Name of Facilitator (s).
